

# The Second Annual O'Leno State Park **FIREFLY ENCOUNTER**

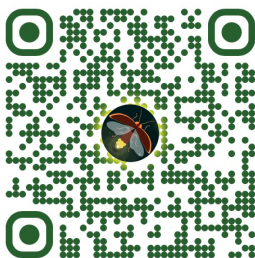
*Learn about fireflies and see thousands of them

special interpretive program on*

**Saturday, April 6<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup>  
from 8 p.m. to 9 p.m.**

Meet at the Pavilion near the river for a short educational presentation.  
You will then be guided on a light hike of no more than 3/4's of a mile  
in little-traveled areas of O'Leno State Park.\*

The \$15 event ticket includes your after-hours park entry fee  
allowing one vehicle with a maximum of 8 passengers.

## IMPORTANT TIPS

-  Avoid using insect repellent! Protect against mosquitoes with long sleeves and pants.
-  No flashlights or cell phone lights allowed. They confuse the fireflies. Rangers and guides will have red-filtered flashlights to guide you in the darkness.
